



### **Barn Manager Position Description**

The position of Barn Manager will complete duties in the East, West, North, Northwest, Northeast, Lower Concourse, Equine Barn, Arenas, tie out areas, wash racks and other designated areas as required. The candidate must act at the direction of the Farm Show management team in the area before, during and after the Farm Show event.

Preferred skills include organization, relationship management, logical thinking, problem solving, conflict management, reading and interpreting floor plans, big picture understanding with attention to detail, and customer service.

- 12 days, 12 hours/day= 144 hours- \$25 per hour, \$3600
  - Hotel, daily per diem paid within 30 days of submission of expenses.
  - Additional hours must be approved in advance.
- Ensure barns are set appropriately
- Ensure stalling is accurately marked and displayed
- Manage barriers that need to be in place
- Welcome exhibitors
- Ensure stalls are mucked prior to departure
- Maintain exhibitor needs (walkways with barn grit, opening and closing overhead doors, barricading areas, electric breaker resets) and other needs to ensure animal/public safety by communicating with proper Farm Show staff
- Direct traffic flow for incoming and outgoing exhibitors
- Act as liaison to Farm Show staff
- Watch for unethical activities
- Receive suggestions and act on them, when possible, to provide a better show experience
